DECISION/RECOMMENDATION

REFINE SELECTED PROGRAM (CAMPAIGN) IN TERMS OF ACTIONS, ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES, TIME PHASING, ETC.

ANNOUNCE DECISION/RECOMMENDATION AND YOUR INTENT.
